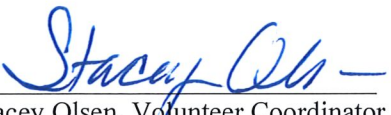

Welcome, Call to Order & Roll Call	Chair Sanchez called the meeting to order at 4:35pm, conducted roll call, welcomed, and thanked everyone for attending.
Minutes	Chair Sanchez asked for a motion to approve May 15, 2025, minutes. Member Hanna motioned to approve the minutes. Seconded by Member Spark. Committee approved.
City Report	<i>Gib's Loop –</i> We had a volunteer project arranged with the high school mountain bike teams and Member Harris to reroute a section of the trail off the golf cart path near hole 6. The route would take people east to Foothill Bridge, then back west to connect with the existing Gib's Loop Trail. The administration asked us to hold off, they want to make sure the community is aware and <i>Dogs and Motorcycles –</i> a. Lt. Cox stated that the Animal Control officers are out watching for dogs off leash. Vice Chair McMillan stated that there are dogs all over 9th Street Bike Park.

	b. Motorcycles are also a concern. They are on the trails and in the parks. Staff Olsen has some more signs on order. <i>Lantern House</i> - is under new management. We may see an influx of homeless activity and camps in town. If you see camps, please report them. <i>QR Code Stickers</i> – There are signs in some of the kiosks that are labeled Trail Etiquette and another called Volunteer Opportunities. The QR code on these signs is no longer working. We have some stickers to put over the old code. Members took stickers to put on the signs. <i>Blue Ribbon Trail</i> – Member Hanna asked about getting the tractor up to help groom the trail now that he has widened it. Supervisor Chadwick said to get with him this fall when we have had some rain.
USFS Updates	Not present Chair Sanchez submitted the volunteer agreement.
Par Course	Member Gentry was not present
Pliking	Project completed at Canyon Trailhead. 5/29 - Beus Pond cleanup is scheduled with Wex and JR Automation. 6/5 – Wasatch Distribution is scheduled to clean Rainbow Trail area. 6/7 – National Trails Day with Trails Utah at Parleys Canyon 6/17 – AAA Kays Creek Parkway 6/29 Jr Automation Parker Drive 9/13 – Gib’s loop, starting at 29th Street. Asked Staff Olsen to add this project to the volunteer site.
2025 Projects	<i>Pump Course</i> – Committee discussed various locations for a track: West Stadium Park, Lorin Farr Park, Big D Park Staff Olsen will reach out to planning and see if they have any land that might work for a track. <i>Swag</i> – Chair Sanchez discussed getting swag to hand out to visitors.
ShinDig	Medical personnel will be staged in key areas Timing and course setup discussed for the Rut Race and 5K Timing to be managed by stop watches. Discussion of including a kids’ race. <i>Confirmed</i> – • Running Race • Bike Race • Band a Union Station • Alcohol • Food
Committee Updates	<i>Open Position</i> - Staff Olsen read of the rules for the committee and confirmed the only open position at this time is for a TFNU Representative.

	<i>Benni Hanna</i> – - Shared some grants he would like to apply for. He would like to see the committee move its focus more on grants and projects and use the Shindig as a celebration, not our main fundraising event. - Trail dig this coming Tuesday, 7pm at Lake Street. <i>Dan Spark</i> – Presented a list of tools he would like to purchase and asked to be reimbursed for the purchase of some batteries for the weed eaters. Member Hanna motioned to approve \$700.00 for tools and to reimburse Member Sparks for the batteries. Seconded by Member Judeikis. All approved. <i>Tara Warren and Aubrey McIntosh</i> – Volunteered to help with the social media presence. Staff Olsen stated that only employees can have access to the actual account, so any content we want posted send it over and we will get it up right away. <i>Joseph Sanchez</i> – Member Hanna motioned to approve a \$4,500.00 budget for the Shindig. Seconded by Member Sparks. The committee agreed to meet after hours to discuss this event. <i>Lavar Harris</i> – discussed the project the high school team completed. <i>Mike Goodrick</i> – he will share the information about the counters. Staff Olsen suggested we gather them, bring them to the office, replace the batteries and determine the locations we would like to set them.
Adjourn	Member Hanna motioned to adjourn. Member Harris seconded. All approved. The Trail Network meeting adjourned at 6:00pm.
