1. HEBER VALLEY EIS UPDATE – CRAIG HANCOCK

- A. **SUMMARY:** Craig Hancock, Utah Department of Transportation Project Manager, presented a progress update related to the Heber Valley Bypass project. Craig provided a summary of: Recent meetings held with various organization and efforts made to respond to property owner inquiries and meeting requests; Current proposed bypass routes; next steps, which includes opportunities for individuals and/or groups to get involved in the evaluation process.

1. MIDA REPORT: MUNICIPAL SERVICES REVENUE FUND REVENUE PROJECTIONS – RICHARD BREITENBEKER.

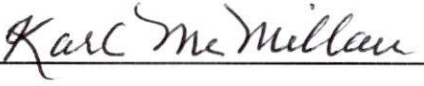

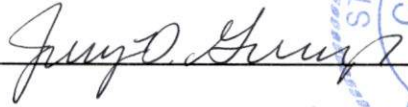
