# PLANNING AND ZONING MEETING MINUTES

#### Opened meeting at 6:05pm, August 11, 2025

- Commission Attendees: Deborah Herron, Danita Hinton, Clay Crozier, Valorie McLean, Lynn Hamilton
- Guest Attendees: Jenny Adams, Karie Morrill

#### **Agenda Items:**

- 1. Prayer by Clay Crozier, Pledge of Allegiance
- 2. Meeting minutes, 7.21.2025 accepted by unanimous vote.
- 3. Zone Change: Karie Morrill, 514 E 400 N
  - a. Wants to change her property zoning from Residential (R) to Residential Agriculture (RA).
  - b. Wants to own and maintain a couple of sheep on her property.
  - c. Property is  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre which meets the lot size requirements to own up to 5 sheep.
  - d. Danita suggests changing all the blocks south of 500 N to be RA rather than just one lot
  - e. Lynn made the motion to recommend changing the blocks south of 500 N between 500 E and 600 E to Residential Agriculture to match the zoning around it. Accepted by unanimous vote.
  - f. Commission discussed the option of offering a conditional use permit or variance instead of changing the zoning.
- 4. Sub-division Ordinance Review
  - a. Clay wants to review/edit the sub-division ordinance that Mike Hanson created to move along the process of recommendation and adoption since the deadline was Dec 31 of 2024.
  - b. Deb had some redlines for who pays the recording fees. Should be the developer, not the city.
  - c. Valorie highlighted the document references the city attorney frequently and possibly incorrectly.
  - d. PZ commission needs to have time to review in depth since it is a long section of ordinance. We will share the redlined copy from Mike Hansen to put our comments in.
    - Does the city council want to delegate or retain their rights to vote and/or sign off on the land use issues with subdivisions?
- 5. Open Session:
  - Valorie noticed that the short-term rental ordinance that we proposed conflicts with the ADU ordinance which restricts that ADU's be used as short-term rentals. So the council will need to decide if they want to change ADU's to
  - b. Danita addressed the need to resign. This will be her last meeting.
