JENNIFER: **THANKED AARON DAVIDSON FOR HIS WORK. EXPRESSED CONCERN AT HOW HE IS BEING TREATED BY COMMISSIONERS POWERS GARDNER AND ASKED HER TO RECUSE HERSELF. POSTPONE CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION**

NATALIE CLAWSON *(Candidate on the ballot)*: **WOULD LIKE THE COMMISSIONERS TO PUSH BACK AGAINST LT GOVERNOR REGARDING CVRS AND NOT HAVING ACCESS TO THAT INFORMATION. CONCERNED THAT SPENCER COX SHOULD NOT HAVE BEEN ON THE BALLOT.**

THOMAS COOK: **THANKED AARON AND HIS STAFF. DO NOT CERTIFY ELECTIONS.**

SUSAN LINFORD: **SPENCER COX WAS NOT ABLE ELIGIBLE TO RUN FOR GOVERNOR, DO NOT CERTIFY ELECTIONS.**

TODD JOHNSON *(Orem Resident)*: **WAIT FOR SCOTUS DECISION BEFORE CERTIFYING THE ELECTIONS. THANKED AARON AND HIS STAFF**

SHERRY PETERSON: **FEELS LIKE THERE IS CORRUPTION IN THE ELECTIONS.**

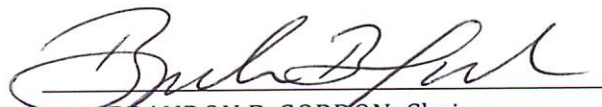

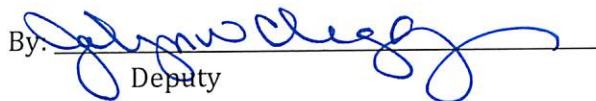
