



**CANVASS REPORT
2025 Municipal Primary Election
Mapleton City, Utah**

The Mapleton City 2025 Primary Municipal Election was held on August 12, 2025 was conducted by Utah County Elections office using Vote by Mail. A municipal primary election was held for one (1) Mayor and (2) City Council seats each for a term of four years.

Mapleton City has a total of 9,732 active registered voters. Of this number, 4,817 voters are classified as private registrations, while 1,405 voter records are withheld pursuant to state voter registration confidentiality provisions.

During the election, a total of 4,084 ballots were cast, resulting in a voter turnout rate of 42.0%.

Mayor

Therin Garrett received 1,679 votes with 41.45% votes cast.

Scott Liggett received 999 votes with 24.66% votes cast.

Claudia Paradis received 90 votes with 2.22% votes cast.

Dallas Hakes received 1,283 votes with 31.67% votes cast.

City Council

Kasey Beck received 1,740 votes with 23.47% votes cast.

Melanie Bott received 1,390 votes with 18.75% votes cast

David Smaldone received 579 votes with 7.81% votes cast

Angela Silva received 1,006 votes with 13.57% votes cast

Francis Gibson received 1,399 votes with 18.87% votes cast

Jake Lake received 1,301 votes with 17.55% votes cast

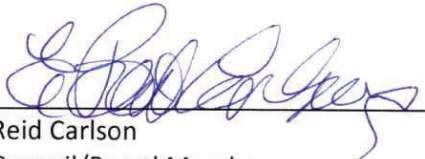

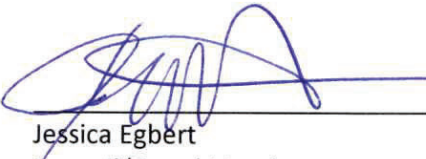

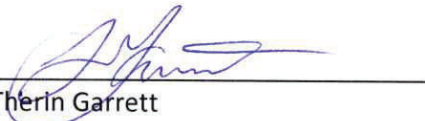
