Proposed Tax Increase FY2025-2026


Facts:

The CUWCD Board of Trustees is considering increasing its tax rate to the statutory authorized rate of 0.0004 from the certified tax rate of 0.000380 to support major capital projects that will be covered. The proposed tax rate increase to 0.0004 will provide an additional **\$6.3 million** over the current certified tax rate of 0.000380.


CUWCD's fiscal year 2025-2026 total budget assuming the authorized rate of 0.0004 is:
