

1 R277. Education, Administration.

2 **R277-125. One Time Capital Appropriations for Small School Districts[Capital**
3 **Projects].**

4 R277-125-1. Authority and Purpose.

5 (1) This rule is authorized by:

6 (a) Utah Constitution Article X, Section 3, which vests general control and
7 supervision over public education in the Board;

8 (b) Subsection 53E-3-401(4), which allows the Board to make rules to execute
9 the Board's duties and responsibilities under the Utah Constitution and state law; [and]

10 (c) Section 53F-10-102, which requires the Board to make rules to establish a
11 process for school districts to submit proposals for funding for capital development
12 projects under Title 53F, Chapter 10, State Funding - Capital Projects[.];

(d) Subsection 53F-10-303(3), which requires the Board to make rules for distribution of the Rural School Sports Facilities Grant.

15 (2) The purpose of this rule is to establish a process for school districts to submit
16 proposals for funding for capital development projects, including:

17 (a) [the Capital Projects Evaluation Panel's] review, prioritization, and
18 recommendations to the Board;

19 (b) the Board's consideration and approval, if applicable, of proposed capital
20 development projects; and

21 (c) management of Capital Projects Evaluation Panel processes and
22 administration.

23 (3) This rule is categorized as Category 3 as described in Rule R277-111.

25 R277-125-2. Definitions.

26 (1) "Capital development project" or "project" means the same as that term is
27 defined in Section 53F-10-101.

(2) "Capital Projects Evaluation Panel" or "panel" means the same as that term is defined in Section 53F-10-101.

30 (3) "Eligible school," for purposes of Section R277-125-6, means the same as the
31 term is defined in Subsection 53F-10-303(1).

32 [(3)](4) "Eligible school district," for purposes of Sections R277-125-3 and R277-
33 125-4, means the same as that term is defined in Section 53F-10-101.

35 **R277-125-3. Superintendent Duties and Support for Capital Development**
36 **Proposal Process.**

37 (1)(a) The Superintendent shall prepare an application for an eligible school
38 district to submit a proposal to the Capital Projects Evaluation Panel for funding for a
39 capital development project.

40 (b) The application described in Subsection (2)(a) shall include a requirement for
41 an eligible school district to provide at least the following information as part of the
42 eligible school district's proposal:

43 (i) a cost analysis and estimate for the project;
44 (ii) a proposed timeline for the project;
45 (iii) if applicable, the source of the eligible school district's matching funds;
46 (iv) the LEA's capital local levy imposed for the most recent fiscal year; and
47 (v) narrative describing how the project will meet the eligible school district's
48 capital needs.

49 (2) As described in Section 53F-10-201, the Superintendent and staff shall
50 participate on the panel and provide staff support.

51 (3) The Superintendent shall provide the panel's recommendations for any
52 project described in Subsection R277-125-4(3)(b) that is \$2 million or more to the Board
53 by January 10 each year for the Board's evaluation and approval.

54 (4) For a project described in Subsection R277-125-4(3)(b) that is less than \$2
55 million, the Superintendent shall:

56 (a) evaluate the panel's recommendations described in Subsection R277-125-
57 4(3)(b);

58 (b) approve and notify an eligible school district of an approved capital
59 development project; and
60 (c) provide a report to the Board of the Superintendent's approvals described in
61 Subsection (4)(b).

62 (5) Subject to the amounts described in Section 53F-10-301 and approval by the
63 Board if applicable, the Superintendent shall distribute funds to an eligible school district
64 with an approved project by March 1.

66 **R277-125-4. Eligible School District Application Requirements -- Panel Review**
67 **and Consideration of Project Proposals.**

68 (1) On or before November 1 each year, an eligible school district may submit a
69 capital development project proposal to the Superintendent using the application
70 described in Subsection R277-124-3(1) for the Capital Projects Evaluation Panel's
71 consideration.

72 (2) To perform the duties described in Section 53F-10-202, the panel shall meet
73 quarterly or as needed.

74 (3) The panel shall:

75 (a) use the criteria described in Subsection 53F-10-202(1) to evaluate and
76 prioritize capital development project proposals; and

77 (b) provide recommendations for proposals that the panel recommends be
78 approved to the Superintendent by December 15.

79 (4) The panel may recommend funds be distributed to an eligible school district
80 for a loan in lieu of a distribution of capital funding for a project as described in Section
81 53F-10-302.

83 R277-125-5. Eligible School District Use of Public Capital and Technology Funds.

84 (1) An eligible school district shall use funds distributed under Section 53F-7-202
85 and this rule by June 30, 2025.

86 (2) An LEA shall return any funds distributed under Section 53F-7-202 and this
87 rule on or before October 1, 2025 if the eligible school district does not expend those
88 funds by June 30, 2025.

90 R277-125-3. Rural School Athletic Grant.

91 (1)(a) The Superintendent shall prepare an application for an eligible school to
92 submit a proposal for the Rural School Sports Facilities Grant Program established in
93 Section 53F-10-303.

94 (b) The application described in Subsection (1)(a) shall include a requirement for
95 an eligible school to provide at least the following information as part of the eligible
96 school's proposal:

97 (i) a cost analysis and estimate for the project;

98 (ii) a proposed timeline for the project;

99 (iii) a narrative describing how the project will meet the eligible school's athletic
100 needs;

101 (iv) the estimated annual maintenance costs for the project;

(v) the estimated time for life cycle replacement of the project; and

103 (vi) the anticipated annual revenue resulting from the project.

104 (2) An eligible school shall submit an application by November 1.

105 (3) The Superintendent shall review applications consistent with the priorities
106 established in Subsection 53F-10-303(3)(b).

107 (4) The Superintendent shall notify an eligible school of awards made by January
108 31.

109 (5) The Superintendent shall distribute funds under this section by February 28.
