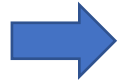

Solution to the Problem

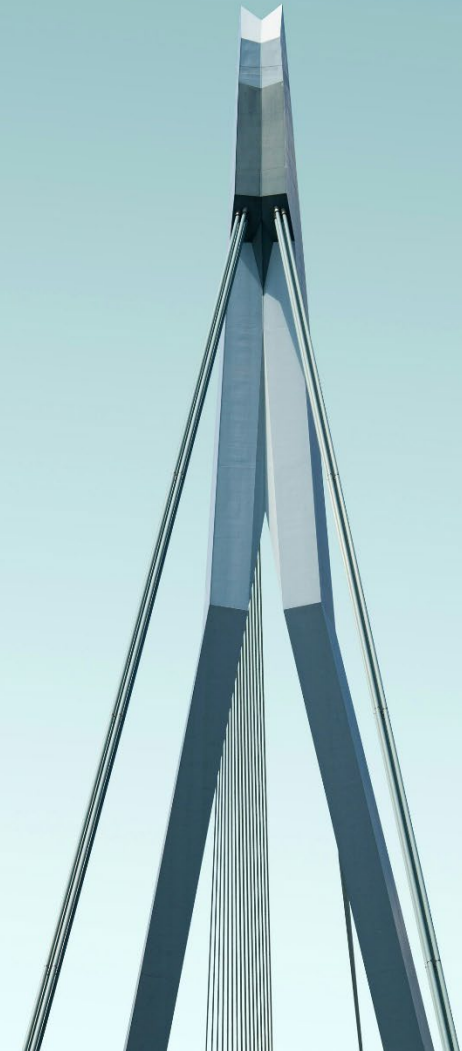
Increase in the Demand for Transactional Data

The state's agencies are needing information transferred from other agencies to effectively conduct business



Bridge , through SLDS23 Grant, is being built to meet the need

The Bridge project is designed to provide agencies with a secure way to respond when individuals make requests.



BRIDGE Applications



- Enrolling into Schools
- Through direct verification with DHHS, schools can confirm the existence and accuracy of a child's birth certificate, eliminating the need for parents to provide physical copies during enrollment.

BRIDGE Applications

- Expanding SSID
- By establishing a reliable source of truth, the project enhances the SSID system, enabling Higher Education and Early Education programs to reduce duplication and improve accuracy. This means parents face fewer paperwork burdens, and students benefit from a clearer, more consistent education record.



BRIDGE Applications



- Higher Education Admittance
- With this solution, students no longer need to manage transcript requests on their own. Their high school records can be securely shared with every higher education institution in Utah, and in return, they receive a clear record of every institution they qualify and have been accepted, reducing the stress for both students and families.
