## **6.3 ACTION: USDB Safety Assessments**

**Committee Discussion:** USDB Staff request legislature change to allow safety inspections to be from the state security chief instead of the county security chiefs.

**Committee Action:** Member Davis moved the Committee recommends the Board request a Code change to reflect the safety assessments for USDB buildings change from county security chief to state safety chief and also direct staff to bring waiver language back to Committee.

Motion passed unanimously.



**Motion for the Board:** The Board request a code change to reflect the safety assessments for USDB building change from the county security chief to the state safety chief and bring any waiver language back to the Committee.

#### **6.4 ACTION: Deaf and Blind Schools Strategic Plans**

**Committee Discussion:** Staff will present the Deaf and Blind Schools Strategic Plans for approval. Staff showed their work on each Strategic Plan. Staff will bring back to the Committee in November Strategic Plans for the next school year.

**Committee Action:** No motion for the Board

#### **6.5 ACTION: R277- 800, Utah Schools for the Deaf and Blind (USDB) (Amendment)**

**Committee Discussion:** The Board will review R277-800-9, which governs the enrollment of hearing siblings at the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind (USDB). This rule allows USDB, under certain conditions, to enroll the hearing sibling of a student who is deaf or hard of hearing and is already enrolled in a USDB campus program.

Key provisions of the rule include:

- Eligibility is limited to siblings of currently enrolled students.
- Enrollment is restricted to one hearing sibling per class.

Each case must be individually evaluated by the USDB Superintendent, with consideration given to:

- The educational benefit for both the deaf student and the hearing sibling.
- The impact on other students in the program.
- The sibling's behavior history or any conditions that could affect the classroom environment.
- The sibling's willingness to learn American Sign Language (ASL) and engage with Deaf culture.

Hearing siblings who are enrolled are entitled to the same rights as traditional public school students. The USDB can rescind this opportunity at any time. Given current budget constraints, it is important to consider whether the rule needs to include language that indicates this is also subject to available funding or whether any updates or clarifications are necessary.
