

August 6, 2025

Open public Hearing – Public comment on adoption of the “Resident Definition” Ordinance.  
Public comment from audience.

Hearing closed -

Public Meeting opened

Vote on ordinance as read made by roll call. Unanimous vote. Yes vote – Mayor Prince,  
Councilmembers Batty, Allan, Pace, and Larsen.

1. Minutes from July meeting read by clerk. Motion to accept made by Larsen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pace.  
Unanimous vote.
2. Discussion of Ordinance violations by town attorney (Heath Snow). Use our penalty for  
violation. Time notice can be 10-30 days. Then we can start fining them.
3. Diana Stiller – Historical Preservation Committee update. Everything will be finished by  
August 2025.
4. Sharing the expenses between the fire district and the town. A letter was sent with a  
billing for past two years. Pat Fleckenstein Chairman, asked if there could be a written  
agreement between the agencies and then bill them quarterly. Council agreed.
5. Reports – Pace-a lot of compliments on the cemetery. Park needs more time being  
watered. Larsen, concerned about notices he is getting about water meters. Batty – can  
the town buy a mini-split. Gave permission to get prices. C- chlorine levels are good.  
Mayor concerned about the church having a higher- than normal bill. Has a lot of  
leftover drinks left over from 4<sup>th</sup>. Would like to sell. Stiller said there are a few events  
still to be held that can be used. Wayne Elwood said that house insurances have been  
creating a moratorium but they are releasing that now.
6. Council members watched a video introducing a water meter system that is available.
7. Motion to adjourn the meeting made by Larsen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Allan. Unanimous vote.
