

CANCELLATION OF SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT ELECTION NOTICE

East Duchesne Culinary Water Improvement District (EDCWID) board of trustees hereby notifies all registered voters/residents of EDCWID that the 2025 Special Service District Election has been cancelled pursuant to §20A-1-206 of the Utah Code due to the number of candidates not exceeding the number of open positions.

The EDCWID board of trustees will pass Resolution 25-1 on September 10, 2025, at the board meeting held once a month, to cancel the 2025 Special Service District Election and hereby certifies that:

1. There are no district ballot propositions for the local election;
2. Each district candidate is unopposed;
3. Each district candidate is considered to be elected to office;
4. The Resolution is passed more than 20 days before the day of the scheduled election.
