

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-XX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN, UTAH, PROVIDING THAT THE VIRGIN MUNICIPAL CODE (VMC) BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 3.06.030 ENTITLED "COMPENSATION" OF SAID CODE, PROVIDING THAT THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED (MAYOR) OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN BE REVISED.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Utah Code Section 10-3-818(1) provides that "elective and statutory officers of municipalities shall receive such compensation for their services as the governing body may fix by ordinance adopting compensation or compensation schedules enacted after public hearing";

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 16, 2025.

WHEREAS, the duties and workload of the mayor will decrease significantly with the hiring of the town manager.

WHEREAS, public service necessitates that the elected and statutory/appointed officers spend their own money in the service of the Town;

WHEREAS, the budget for FY 2025/2026 was adopted on June 17, 2025 which included the necessary funds for the current compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby finds that the mayor should be fairly compensated for their time and expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN, UTAH:

Section 1. That section 3.06.030 of the Virgin Municipal Code of the Town of Virgin, Utah, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

3.06.030 Compensation

The monthly compensation of the mayor shall be as follows:

Section 2. The aforementioned compensation shall be active as of October 1, 2025.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, clause, or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Conflicts/Repealer. This Ordinance repeals and supersedes the provisions of any prior ordinance in conflict herewith.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Virgin Town Council and execution by the Virgin Town Mayor with Compensation being made affective starting October 1, 2025.
