

Resolution 9-9-2025

A RESOLUTION CANCELLING LOCAL ELECTION PERSUANT TO §20A-1-206 OF THE UTAH STATE CODE DUE TO NUMBER OF CANDIDATES NOT EXCEEDING THE NUMBER OF OPEN OFFICES.

WHEREAS, Fayette had scheduled an election for November 4th, 2025, to fill two 4-year terms; and

WHEREAS, there are presently two candidates to fill the two 4-year terms:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF FAYETTE THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

I. MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANCELLED

The Town Council hereby certifies:

- a. There are no municipal ballot propositions for the local election;
- b. Each municipal officer candidates is unopposed;
- c. Each municipal officer is a candidate for a municipal office for which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of open municipal offices;
- d. Each municipal officer candidate is considered to be elected to office.
- e. This Resolution is passed more than 20 days before the day of the scheduled election.
