Yard Goat Tournaments

Kyle Graham and Shane Nelson attended representing the Yard Goats. Yard Goats explained that only their annual tournament generates revenue, which is distributed evenly among all participants, they noted significant volunteer contributions of personal time and money to prepare fields. Chairman Anderson suggested continuing current field usage but requested Yard Goats assist with completing the building and other improvements. Proposal to create an **in-kind labor agreement** for clarification. Kyle Graham requested clarification on why this concern is arising now. Mayor Leatherwood explained that community members are concerned about field access and light usage. The Recreation Department emphasized the need for transparency and fairness for all groups.

- Noted: Yard Goats are a **non-profit organization**.

Hole & Water Problems at Ball Fields (North Entry)

Holes were found in the backstops; repairs are needed. Markell reported that new belting is being fabricated. A large muddy hole on the north side presents a safety hazard for children and requires repair.

Field Improvements

Chairman Anderson states the weeds on fields need removal. Chairman Anderson also reminds the group that the building remains unfinished, and assistance is needed to complete it.
