Dear Board

The need for water for industries that are looking to move into the county is growing. In an attempt to be ready for the day when they come looking we request that the water rights associated with the Scofield Property be made available to industry. The value of using the water for industry is much more valuable to the citizens than leasing the property and water for grazing.

One other option for this water would be to use it on the Back Nine of the Golf Course that you own. Curtis Page ran a report on 2022 regarding the water use on the Back Nine. You own a spring that produces an average of 108 acre feet of water per year. This average was calculated from 2013 to 2021. The average water use on the Back Nine is 161 acre feet per year. This leaves a shortage of 53 acre feet of water to supplement the spring. These 53 acre feet could be supplied by your own water right.

The following water rights are owned by your board.
