

RESOLUTION 2025-12

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE EMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN AS THE OFFICIAL EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR ORANGEVILLE CITY.

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. §53-2a-104 and related provisions authorize and encourage local jurisdictions to develop, adopt, and maintain emergency operations plans to ensure effective response and recovery in the event of disasters, emergencies, or hazards; and

WHEREAS, Emery County has prepared and adopted a comprehensive Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) to coordinate emergency management activities and resources within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Emery County Emergency Operations Plan is consistent with state and federal guidelines, meets the requirements of the National Incident Management System (NIMS), and provides for coordination among county, municipal, state, and federal agencies during emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Orangeville City (“**City**”) recognizes that adoption of the Emery County Emergency Operations Plan will promote efficient and coordinated emergency response, reduce duplication of efforts, and enhance public safety within the city; and

WHEREAS, the Orangeville City Council (“**Council**”) finds that adopting the Emery County Emergency Operations Plan as the official Emergency Operations Plan for Orangeville City (**City**) serves the best interests of the City and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ORANGEVILLE CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Adoption-** Orangeville City hereby adopts the Emery County Emergency Operations Plan, as may be amended from time to time, as the official Emergency Operations Plan for Orangeville City.
- 2. Implementation-** All city officials, employees, and emergency personnel shall familiarize themselves with the Emery County Emergency Operations Plan and cooperate in its implementation during emergencies, disasters, and training exercises.
- 3. Coordination-** The Mayor, or their designee, shall coordinate with the Emery County Emergency Manager and other relevant agencies to ensure the plan remains current, effective, and in alignment with City needs.
- 4. Effective Date-** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
