Expand recreation programs. 36 Shade structures at playgrounds. 37 Benches in parks. 38 City bike map. 39 • Bike skills park (skate park). 40 • City property by the "V" to be developed. 41 Trails improved north of Chase Lane. 42 43 • Bike stations installed at parks. National Recreation and Parks Association (NRPA) standards need to be met. 44
