



OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF 2025 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

The 2025 Municipal General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters, beginning October 14. To receive a ballot, voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the City in which they are registered.

Voters can verify registration status at <https://vote.utah.gov/>.

Registered voters who do not receive a ballot or anyone with questions about their ballot should contact the Cache County Clerk's Office at www.CacheCounty.org/Elections or call the Cache County Clerk's Office at 435-755-1460.

Election Day In-Person Voting will be open on Tuesday, November 4 from 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM at the Cache County Event Center (Fairgrounds), 490 South 500 West, Logan, Utah. **VALID VOTER IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.**

Ballots can also be returned by mail (postage is paid) or in person at the Cache County Clerk's Office 179 N Main (inside during regular business hours) or outside 24/7 at this location. Polls close at these locations at 8:00 PM on Tuesday, November 4, 2025 and no ballots will be accepted after this time.
