b. Report from City Council

Councilman Tim Shupe reported concerns about stop signs at 2575 W 2825 N from public comment. Jason has given council guidance with the help of traffic committee, the City Council to mitigate traffic concerns. CRA held a joint meeting where a public hearing was held to consider the Farr West Landing Community Reinvestment Project Area Plan. The Council approved business licenses for NMR Properties, LLC, Snow Squad, and Car Shine Pros, LLC. One entity was tabled for licensure due to lack of

representation. The request to vacate the public utility easements for Ryan Smith was approved. Regarding the Annexation Plan, the Council will be seeking guidance from the Planning Commission in the future to make sure the city is in compliance with state legislature. There was a funding request for a community musical. The Council then reported on assignments and adjourned. Katie reported on disc golf at Parks Meeting and has met with a citizen from Farr West to discuss funding to finish the project of the new disc golf course.

Lyle: Nate Carver asked for guidance on this ordinance, as it stands any property less than an acre, the roof at its peak is 20' and 15' at wall height. To allow for standard doors and recreational vehicles in garages. Raising 1' on peak and walls to 21' and 16' respectively. On lots 1 acre or larger restrictions of roof peak 25' and wall height of 18'.

Leah Mossler – 3056 W 3600 N, house has no neighbors and is on ¾ acre lot. She wants 24' peak and 19' wall height for building to accommodate a recreational vehicle and daughter's hobby. She has been to the city building and was told almost no one receives variance. She is asking for variance. She would like this ordinance to include room for case-by-case basis.

Genneva encouraged her to seek variance but also cautioned that legally, exceptions are difficult for the city to defend if challenged.

Tavin Rose – 2684 Remuda Drive, supports and appreciates this.
