

# What is the Utah Waste Management Plan?

Provides an estimate of solid waste capacity needed in the state for the next 20 years.

Assesses the state's ability to minimize waste and recycle.

Evaluates solid waste treatment, disposal, and storage options, as well as solid waste needs and existing capacity.

Evaluates facility siting, design, and operation.

Reviews funding alternatives for solid waste management.

Addresses other solid waste management concerns that the board finds appropriate for the preservation of public health and the environment.

# Utah Waste Management Plan Background

Utah Code <u>§19-6-104(3)</u> was established in 1994


The State of Utah requires an updated Plan "no less frequently than once every five years."

The last update was performed in 2007

## Statewide Waste Characterization Study

In 2023 the Solid Waste program was awarded one of the EPA's Solid Waste Infrastructure for Recycling grants to conduct a statewide waste characterization study, analyzation of the Utah Recycling Survey and update the Utah Waste Management Plan.
