A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CHIEF TOQUER RESERVOIR RECREATION COMMITTEE

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the Washington County Water Conservancy District is constructing the Chief Toquer Reservoir with an anticipated completion date in Fall 2026; and

WHEREAS, while the primary purpose of the reservoir is water storage, the District has designated an area to be used for recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Toquerville seeks to ensure coordinated planning, community involvement, and identification of funding opportunities for recreational improvements at the reservoir; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the formation of a committee to serve as a recommending body to the City Council for the purpose of guiding recreation planning associated with the reservoir project;

RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. **Creation.** The Chief Toquer Reservoir Recreation Committee is hereby established as a recommending body to the City Council.
2. **Membership and Appointment.**
 - The Committee shall consist of:
 - i. One representative from Ash Creek Special Service District;
 - ii. One representative from the Washington County Water Conservancy District;
 - iii. Three community members who are registered voters residing in Toquerville; and
 - iv. One non-voting City staff member to provide administrative support.
 - The Mayor shall appoint committee members with the recommendation of the City Council.
 - Appointments shall endure through completion of the project unless a member resigns or is removed.
 - The City Council may vote to remove a member if deemed necessary.
 - Vacancies shall be filled by the same appointment process.
 - The Committee shall elect its own chair.

3. **Objectives.** The Committee shall:

- Review and advise staff on the draft Memorandum of Understanding with the Washington County Water Conservancy District, providing direction for staff to negotiate terms;
- Develop a vision for recreational facilities serving a variety of user groups;
- Propose a conceptual layout and phased amenities as appropriate;
- Review grant applications prepared by City staff prior to submittal;
- Identify funding opportunities, with any use of matching funds requiring City Council budgetary approval;
- Encourage community engagement and input regarding recreational planning.

4. **Meetings.** The Committee shall meet quarterly and conduct meetings in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order.

5. **Duration.** The Committee shall automatically dissolve upon completion of the project, by City Council action, or four (4) years from the date of this Resolution, whichever occurs first.
