A RESOLUTION SETTING NEW CULINARY WATER RATES

WHEREAS: Sterling Town owns and operates a culinary water system; and

WHEREAS: Costs associated with managing and operating the system continue to increase; and

WHEREAS: Revenues must be increased to maintain operations, provide for emergencies, and build reserves for future repairs and improvements; and

WHEREAS: The Sterling Town Council previously adopted Resolution #20210420 establishing water rates; and

WHEREAS: The Council finds it necessary to update and amend the rates to ensure fairness and sustainability; and

WHEREAS: The Sterling Town Council finds it fair and equitable for Non-Resident Water Users to pay a monthly fee in addition to the base rate in order to reflect the additional costs of extending and providing culinary water service outside the Town limits; and

WHEREAS: It is a privilege, rather than a right, for Non-Residents to receive culinary water from the Town; and

WHEREAS: The Sterling Town Council has adopted the Ordinance governing its operation which provides, among other things, with the right to change or fix water rates by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF STERLING TOWN, SANPETE COUNTY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: WATER RATES

As of _____, 2025, the monthly culinary water user rates shall be as follows:

Within Town Limit (Resident) Users:

Monthly Base Rate: \$35.00 for up to 7,000 gallons per month

Overage Rate: \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons for all usage over 7,000 gallons

Outside Town Limit (Non-Resident) Users:

Monthly Base Rate: \$35.00 for up to 7,000 gallons per month

Non-Resident Surcharge: \$15.00 per month



Overage Rate: \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons for all usage over 7,000 gallons
