

## RESOLUTION 09- 01-2025

### A RESOLUTION OF THE SANTAQUIN CITY COUNCIL CANCELING THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE

**WHEREAS**, the City of Santaquin, as a municipality of the state of Utah, provides that City Elections shall be held in accordance with the laws of the State of Utah; and

**WHEREAS**, Utah Code Annotated § 20A-1-202 establishes the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each odd-numbered year for the purposes of conducting a municipal general election; and

**WHEREAS**, no proposition is to appear on the ballot in the election; and

**WHEREAS**, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy have passed; and

**WHEREAS**, each municipal officer candidate is unopposed; and


**WHEREAS**, Utah Code Annotated § 20A-1-206 specifically provides for a process whereby the City may cancel a municipal general election when the series of events identified above have occurred and upon compliance with applicable law.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTAQUIN CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The November 4, 2025 municipal general election is canceled.
2. The Santaquin City Council certifies that the ballot would not include any contested races or ballot propositions.
3. Each of the candidates is considered elected to office.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon approval.
