2. Used for agricultural purposes

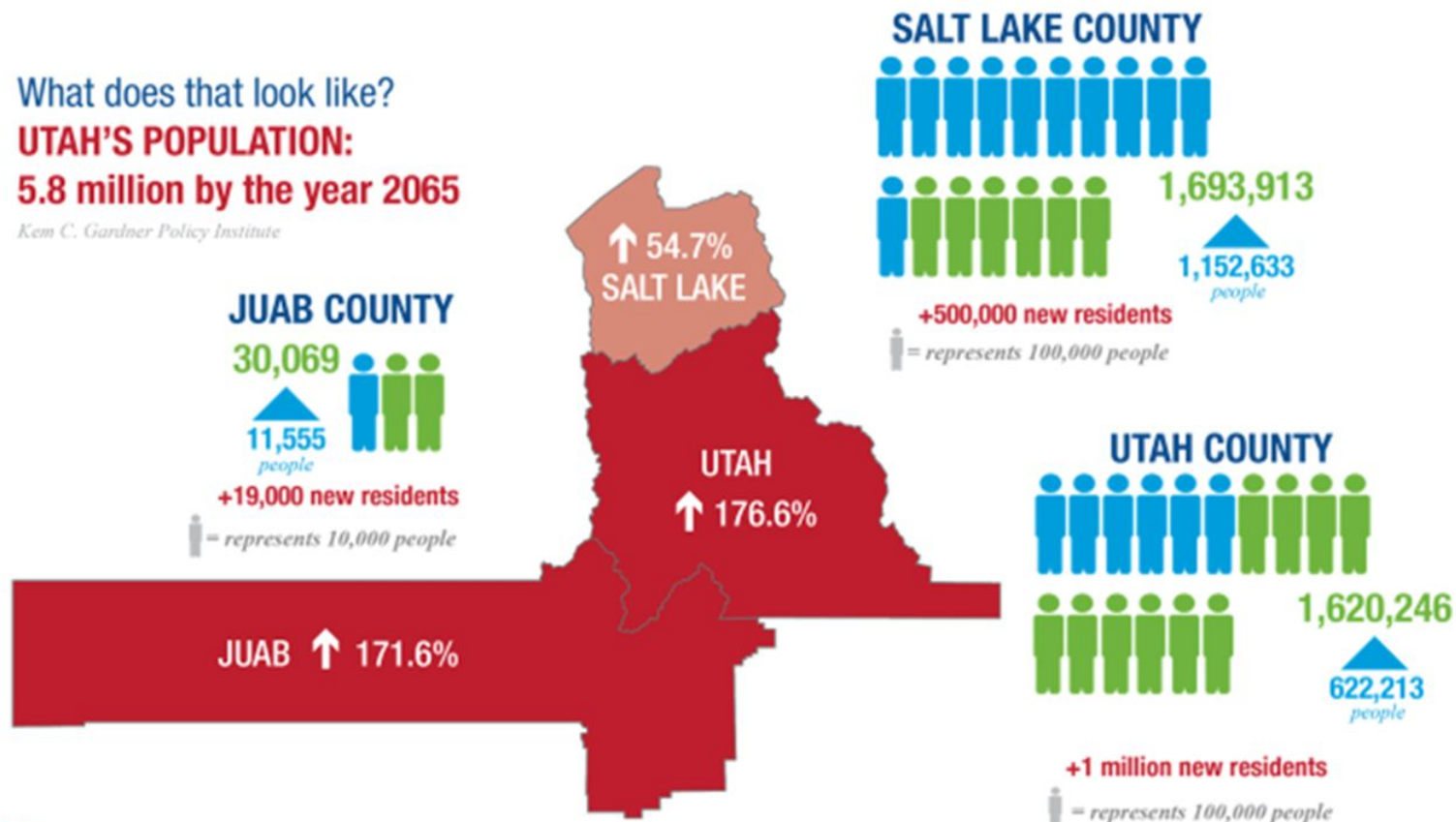

5.8 million by the year 2065

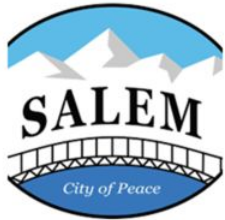

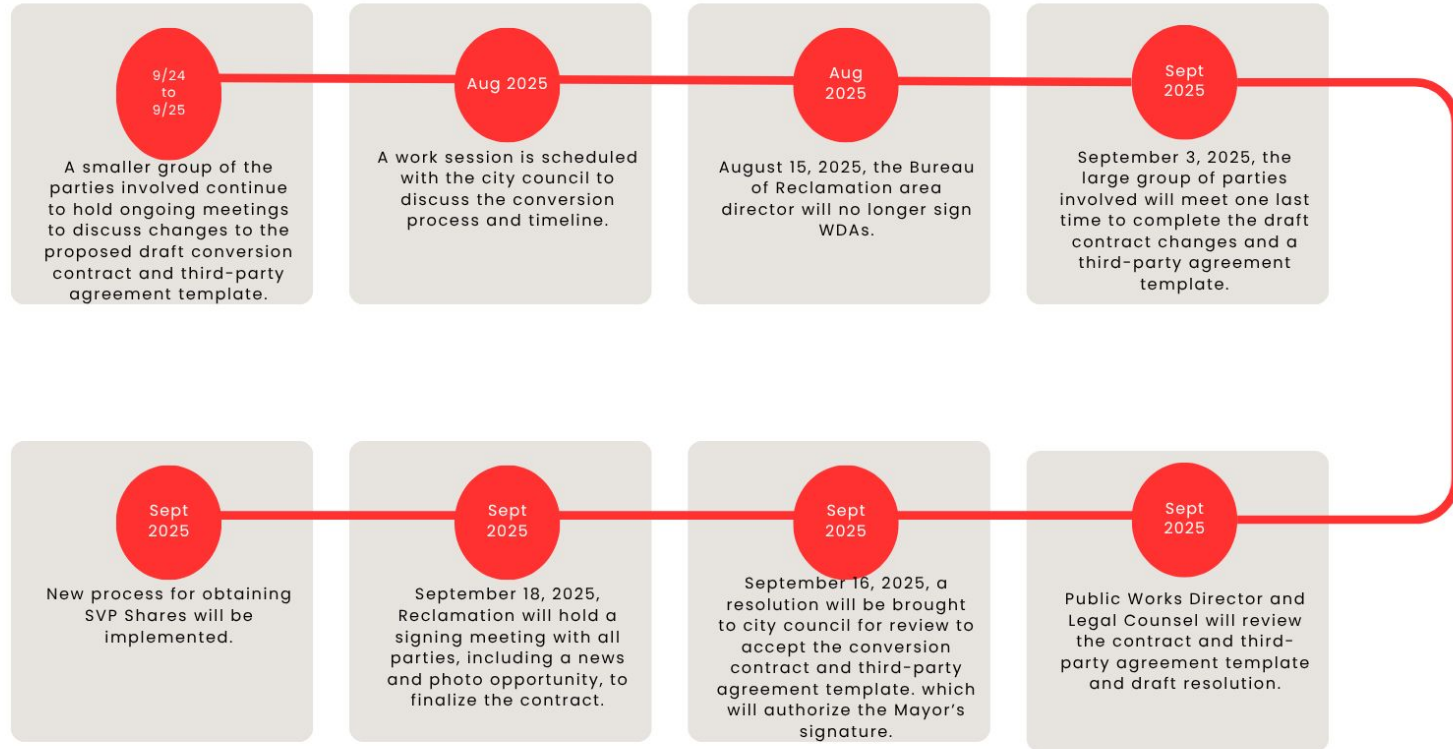

HISTORY OF SVP SHARES AND SFC



KEY POINTS OF MISCELLANEOUS PURPOSES CONTRACT



- United States (Bureau of Reclamation)
- Multiple Irrigation Companies
- Municipalities: Salem, Payson, Spanish Fork
- Strawberry Water Users Association (SWUA)
- Individual Water Users

PARTIES INVOLVED



- Authorizes the use of Strawberry Valley Project (SVP) water for Miscellaneous Purposes.
- Historically, SVP water was restricted to irrigation use

PURPOSE OF CONTRACT



- Allowed only after execution of Third-Party Agreements
- Water may no longer be appurtenant to land (can be used anywhere within SVP service area)
- Subject to Reclamation review and approval

USE OF WATER FOR MISCELLANEOUS PURPOSES



- Permitted between Canal Companies with third-party agreement
- Must not negatively affect irrigation users
- Carrier Water must be maintained

INTER-CANAL TRANSFERS



- Provisions for Carrier Water
- Continued Payment to Canal Companies for assessments
- Acknowledgement that no new water right is created
- Compliance with federal and state law

THIRD-PARTY CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

Recommendation:

Approve the Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Sign the SVP Contract and the Public Works Director to Sign Third-party Contracts for SVP Water Dedications.
