The defendant filed a motion to withdraw his plea. The Committee discussed recent appellate decision on State v. Rippey that resulted in more defendants filing motions to withdraw their pleas. The Committee determined that the hearings that have occurred thus far in the case are not included in the victims' rights statute as an important criminal justice hearing which entitles victims to notification.
	<b>Motion</b> : Brandon Simmons makes a motion to close the complaint with no victim rights violation found as the hearing that occurred does not qualify as an important criminal justice hearing for which a victim has a right to receive notification. Wendy Isom seconds the motion. The motion passes. None were opposed.
	<b>Action Items</b> : Rachel Miller will prepare a letter closing the complaint. Katie Fox will send the letter to W.B. and offer resources. Katie Fox will also inform them of the next court date on August 18, 2025.

	The Committee discussed T.M.'s complaint. T.M. 's complaint was filed by their attorney. The defendant had a plea in abeyance agreement that was terminated early due to a request from Adult Probation & Parole that the defendant's probation be terminated early. The court sent notice to the defense and prosecution and terminated the plea in abeyance agreement when they did not hear from either party. Brandon Simmons abstained from giving input on the complaint other than to provide factual information.
