Minutes of August 20, 2025

Councilwoman Fisher moved to approve the minutes from August 20, 2025. Seconded by Councilman Hammond. Carries 4-0.

Jeremy Vincent- GVHS Swim Team/Gunnison Recreation Swim Program Scoreboard Donation

Jeremy Vincent is in attendance to ask for a donation for a new scoreboard they have purchased for the GVHS Swim team and Gunnison Valley Recreation swim team program. Jeremy is asking for a \$1,000 donation for advertisement to be put on the back of the scoreboard for a lifetime advertisement.

Councilwoman Fisher made a motion to donate \$1,000 to the Gunnison Valley High School swim team and Gunnison Valley Recreation program for advertisement. Seconded by Councilman Christensen. Carries 4-0.

Centerfield City Slogan and Motto- Councilwoman Fisher

Councilwoman Fisher mentioned she had sent a survey out and the top vote for a motto was- Built on freedom, strengthened by family, growing through community. For the slogan- Stronger together. Councilman Hansen wondered how many people took the survey. Between the two surveys sent out, 95 people voted.

Councilwoman Fisher made a motion to adopt a motto (Built on freedom, strengthened by family, growing through community) and slogan (Stronger together) for Centerfield City. Seconded by Councilman Hammond. Discussion was had on where the survey was sent out/or advertised. It was sent through text message, social media campaigns, Centerfield City website and the city sign. Carries 4-0.

Unfinished Business/Report of Council Members

Mayor Leatherwood-

Mayor Leatherwood mentioned the ULCT conference in SLC will be held October 1-2. Please let Recorder Belnap know if you are or are not planning to attend.

October 7 there is CDBG training at the R6 building in Richfield from 6-8 PM.

Mayor Leatherwood would like to have a discussion at the next city council meeting about annexation and where we would like to possibly annex in the future. Mayor Leatherwood requested council to drive around and look at roads, infrastructure, etc.

The master drainage plan did not make it on the CIB list for some reason. Will make sure it gets put on the list in March 2026. Hope to have everything ready to apply in June 2026.

Mayor Leatherwood sent out an example of a xeriscape ordinance. Councilman Hansen made a few comments, but the Mayor would like more input and changes if necessary. He would like those by the end of the month so a public hearing can be held at the next planning and zoning meeting. Council approval first meeting in October, effective 90 days after passage.

Brittney Fisher-

Councilwoman Fisher commented that the Harvest Moon Festival did a float in the parade at the Sanpete county fair, great advertisement method. Councilman Christensen has hung up a couple signs around town advertising the festival.

Jon Hansen-

Councilman Hansen mentioned irrigation water has dropped a couple times since the last meeting. Water is about gone, and will be shutting off soon.

Bart Hammond-

The sewer irrigation project did not get put on the CIB list for Gunnison/Centerfield project. Will get it on the list in March of 2026. Can apply in June 2026.

Jonah Christensen-

Councilman Christensen mentioned while talking with Garrick today, he suggested Jonah get certified in the water treatment plant before doing the sewer lagoon certification. Jonah just took his cross connection exam last week and is waiting to hear back. Secondary meter installation in August was a little slow, September numbers have been stronger so far. Both culdesacs of Kasey Petersen's need to be sealed. Received a bid for \$5,600.

Gunnison Valley Police Department Report- Chief Adamson

Chief Adamson from the Gunnison Valley Police Department is in attendance to give a report on the month of August 2025. Nothing serious or out of the ordinary. The website is almost ready. Will be participating in the homecoming parade, homecoming game, United We March Gut Check and the Harvest Moon Festival. Recognized a couple citizens that stepped in and helped with the Vincent accident in July in the Gunnison city council meeting tonight.

Bart asked if anyone else signed up to run for council. They did not. Mayor Leatherwood invited council to talk with residents and see if anyone is interested.

Councilman Hansen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Councilwoman Fisher. Carries 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:51 PM.
