

**SANPETE COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING**  
**May 11, 2010, 11:00 A.M.**  
Sanpete County Courthouse, 160 North Main, Room 303, Manti, Utah

Present are: Commission Chair Claudia Jarrett, Commissioner Spencer Cox, and County Clerk Sandy Neill. Commissioner Steve Frischknecht and County Attorney Ross Blackham are excused. Present from the media is C.R. Truitt.

Meeting is called to order by Commission Chair Claudia Jarrett.

**CLAIMS**

Auditor Ilene Roth is present. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve payment of claims #323173 through #323261. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve payment of claims #323262 through #323332. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**SHERIFF KEVIN HOLMAN: APPROVAL OF FATPOT MOBILE CLIENT ANNUAL LICENSE FOR 5 USERS; APPROVAL TO HIRE ERIC ZEEMAN AS A PATROL DEPUTY AND APPROVAL OF CELL PHONE STIPEND AND CAR WASH ALLOWANCE FOR DEPUTY ZEEMAN; APPROVAL TO HIRE CHAD MOORE AS A CORRECTIONS DEPUTY; APPROVAL FOR PROMOTION OF JESS BAILEY TO CORRECTIONAL SERGEANT; APPROVAL TO PURCHASE CHAIRS FOR THE CONTROL ROOM**

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the payment of \$2,000.00 to FATPOT Technologies for annual licensing for 5 users. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the hiring of Eric Zeeman as a Patrol Deputy at the rate of \$15.81 per hour effective May 11, 2010, and approve a cell phone stipend and car wash allowance for him. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. These new employee's uniforms will come from the annual clothing allowance. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the hiring of Chad Moore as a corrections deputy at a rate of \$16.00 per hour effective May 17, 2010. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the promotion of Jess Bailey to correctional sergeant with a pay increase of 90¢ per hour, effective May 16, 2010. This pay increase does not involve new money. The former sergeant took a cut in pay to move to the road division. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the purchase of nine chairs for the jail at a cost of \$4,824.00. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**FRANCIS NIELSON REPRESENTING GARN AEYWOOD: APPROVAL OF PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND REMOVE S 50095 FROM MAY TAX SALE**

Francis Nielson attempted to call twice, and was unavailable when we tried to call him. He represents Garn Aeywood who is purchasing this property. One thousand dollars was paid toward the back taxes. The administrative fee and the assessment for the Indianola Valley Fire Department have also been paid. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to remove S 50095 from the May Tax Sale. The remaining taxes, penalty and interest will need to be paid in full by November 1, 2010. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**PEGGY AND JESSIE BARNEY: APPROVAL OF PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND REMOVE S 3510x4 FROM MAY TAX SALE**

No one is present for this matter. The administrative fee has been paid. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to remove S 3510x4 from the May tax sale, and allow the remainder of the taxes, penalties and interest by November 1, 2010. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**MIGUEL AVILA: APPROVAL OF PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND REMOVE S 60890 FROM THE MAY TAX SALE**

Miguel Avila is present. Commissioner Cox addresses Mr. Avila in Spanish, and interprets the information for the record. Mr. Avila purchased a home, and understood that the taxes were to be paid out of his monthly payments. His mailing address on his tax notices has changed, and he was not receiving the notices. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve a payment schedule as follows: \$530.23 (administrative fee and IVFDSAA assessment) to be paid by Thursday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, make payments of at least \$200 per month for 16 months, waive penalties and interest, and remove S 60890 from the May tax sale. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. Mr. Avila will update his mailing address with the County treasurer.

**SHANNON REYNOLDS: APPROVAL OF PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND REMOVE S 24648 FROM MAY TAX SALE**

Shannon Reynolds appears by phone. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve a payment schedule as follows: \$530.23 to be mailed today, and received by Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, (to pay the administrative fee and the IVFDSAA fee). The remaining balance of overdue taxes, interest and penalties needs to be paid in full before November 1, 2010. If the first check needs is received by Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, S 24648 will be removed from the May tax sale. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF PAYMENT REQUEST AND PROGRESS REPORT ON THE AXTELL BRIDGE OVER THE SEVIER RIVER PROJECT**

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the payment request for \$16,263.31 on the Axtell Bridge project. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. The payment will be made by UDOT.

**APPROVAL OF FEE SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURES FOR FILLING TAX ROLL AND OTHER SIMILAR RECORDS REQUESTS**

Reed Hatch and Wayne Larsen are present. A request has been made to receive all of our tax rolls in either electronic or printed format. The County will only provide these documents in written format, at a charge of 50¢ per page if picked up in office, and \$1.00 per page if the documents need to be sent. The documents will be prepared based on the amount of information requested. If information for 2 accounts can fit on 1 page that will be allowed. The charge is per page, not per account. The Commission desires to protect the citizens of Sanpete from harassment. A data use agreement will need to be signed before these documents are prepared and released. The agreement prohibits selling this information. Motion is made that this records request will be treated the same as other similar requests. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF UDOT FEDERAL AID AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENT FOR AXTELL BRIDGE OVER THE SEVIER RIVER**

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the UDOT Federal Aid Agreement for the Axtell Bridge. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes. The amount of federal aid will be \$480,164.00, and the County SSD will contribute \$120,041.00.

**APPROVAL OF POLL WORKERS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION**

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to appoint poll workers for the Primary Election to be held on June 22, 2010. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to adjourn. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Jarrett, and the motion passes.
