Meeting Minutes

GIS Steering Committee updates (Informational)

STWG (Solutions and Technology Working Group)

- Mark Miller has been assisting Group with a SWOT analysis, additional information to be given at a future GIS Steering committee meeting.
- STWG is restarting quarterly County GIS User group meetings. Those with current ESRI licenses were invited and meetings are open to all interested in GIS.

ESRI User Conference

- Lindsay Bentley spoke about attending the 2025 ESRI User conference held in July 14–18, 2025 in San Diego. 2024 conference had 23,000 in-person attendees, 16,000 online from over 130 countries making it the largest GIS conference in the world. There were over 200 vendors present to discuss technologies that work with GIS. There were presentations and technical sessions on all subjects and areas of GIS usage and updates on new applications, changes, & applications being phased out. Some apps currently used by SL Co are being retired requiring much of what has been built will need to be converted or rebuilt.
- AI usage in GIS was a high-interest topic and how it can make certain functions more efficient. Some items that were demoed include image to text, audio to text, translation assistant, and legal description to boundary drawing utility.
- The county has 10 free in-person registrations, which we encourage GIS users to use to attend the 2026 conference. In-person attendees have access to hands-on workshops, networking with others in the industry, and ability to stay on the forefront of GIS technology. Each conference has free virtual seminars everyone can attend as well. It was noted that sometimes users don't understand the full capabilities of the ESRI software, so having users attend the conference and share their knowledge both with users and non-users is extremely valuable.
