A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026

WHEREAS, Huntington City has a need to open the fiscal year 2026 budget for adjustments in revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the public interest will be best served by adjusting the budget for the fiscal year 2026,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Huntington City Council that; on the recommendation of the budget officer make the following budget adjustments:

General Fund: Changes made in the following departments:

Increase of revenue from \$1,164,860.00 to \$1,244,810.00

Public Safety – increase budget from \$105,000 to \$109,700.00

Highways and Public Improvements - increase budget from \$332,200.00 to \$382,200.00

Parks, Recreation and Public Property – increase budget from \$322,300.00 to \$347,550.00

Utility Fund: increase expenses from \$540,891.00 to \$565,891.00

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that other adjustments will be made as needed and recommended by the budget officer to all of the funds which may or may not affect the total budgeted amounts for those funds to be in compliance with state codes and that will balance the budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and replaces any resolution in conflict therewith.
