Agenda Item 1. Discuss/approve/deny: Recreation Projects/Grants the Council discussed a grant currently open for applications through the Emery County Tourism Department. Proposed projects include upgrades to the rodeo grounds—specifically the roping boxes—a new pickleball court at Lions Park, and the addition of a disc golf course and walking trail near the rodeo grounds. The estimated cost for the roping boxes and pickleball court is \$250,000. Council members are in the process of obtaining firm cost estimates to support the grant application. The disc golf and walking trail project is estimated at \$1.5 million and would likely require funding through a separate trails grant.

Agenda Item 2. Discuss/approve/deny: Other City Projects the Council proposed several potential projects, including parking strips, a soccer field, and possibly installing lights at Hart's baseball field. Other ideas included a 100x200 metal building with an indoor kitchen, new pickleball courts, batting cages, and the development of a safe route to school from Center Street to 400 North.
