## RESOLUTION No. 2025-30

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH SALT LAKE COUNTY FOR PASSTHROUGH FUNDING OF MILLCREEK CANYON RESTROOM MAINTENANCE

**WHEREAS**, UTAH CODE ANN. §11-13-101, *et seq.* (the “*Interlocal Cooperation Act*”) provides that any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action following the adoption of an appropriate resolution by the governing body of each participating public agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Central Wasatch Commission (“CWC”) is an interlocal entity with jurisdiction over and/or interest in the Central Wasatch Mountains, including Millcreek Canyon (the “*Canyon*”); and

**WHEREAS**, by contract (the “*Collection Agreement*”) with the U.S. Forest Service (“USFS”), Salt Lake County (“*County*”) collects and deposits use fees for the Canyon on behalf of USFS to maintain and improve recreation facilities and natural resources for the Canyon; and

**WHEREAS**, CWC, County and USFS are public agencies for purposes of the Interlocal Act; and

**WHEREAS**, because providing clean and stocked public restrooms in Millcreek Canyon and the other canyons in CWC’s jurisdiction is essential to protect and promote water quality, sanitation and aesthetics, CWC (as project administrator) heretofore has entered into an agreement whereunder a qualified third-party provider (the “*Provider*”) will perform year-round cleaning, stocking and related services in those public restrooms (the “*Project*”); and

**WHEREAS**, USFS has directed County to withhold up to \$40,000 of the fees (the “*Funds*”) collected under the Collection Agreement and pass those funds on to CWC to provide for removal of garbage, occasional snow removal, purchasing restroom supplies, and pumping vault toilets on USPS land and property in the Canyon; and

**WHEREAS**, consequently, CWC and County desire to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement providing for passthrough of the Funds from County to CWC to defray CWC’s costs of providing the services in the Canyon desired by them and USFS (the “*Agreement*”), a copy of which is attached as an exhibit to this resolution (this “*Resolution*”); and

**WHEREAS**, the CWC’s governing body (the “*Board*”) met in regular session on 25 September 2025 to consider, among other things, approving and ratifying CWC’s entry into the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing the form of the Agreement and careful consideration, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of CWC and its constituents to approve and ratify CWC’s entry into the Agreement as proposed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Central Wasatch Commission that the attached Agreement is hereby approved and ratified, and that CWC's chair and secretary are authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of CWC.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2025-30, shall take effect as provided herein.
