APPROVAL OF MINUTES

DISTRICT AND CANYONS INNOVATION CENTER UPDATE- Dr. Rick Robins, Superintendent and Reid Newey, Director of Innovation Center

- Meeting recording started after Rick's welcome, due to recorder issues.
- State of the District report- Presentation
 - 73% of ACT test takers scored about 18- No. 1 district in Utah
 - Class of 2025 had \$50 million in scholarship offers
 - Eastmont is going to be online as the new school year begins. They are hoping to be in person on Sept. 2.
 - Reviewed School improvements, Jordan, Eastmont, Hillcrest, Corner Canyon
 - Employee Satisfaction
 - Teacher Retention 90%
 - Teacher Satisfaction 78%
 - o Students
 - Total enrollment is 32,289
 - 1-2% decline
 - 79 languages are spoken
 - Challenges and Opportunities
 - Chronic absenteeism 31%
 - New initiative of Every Day Counts, possible area to support as a board.

- High School absenteeism is 43%
- Math and Science proficiency is down 2.3%
- Portrait of a Scholar
 - How we are evolving as a school for workforce development
 - Evaluate and map it all the way down to our elementary schools
 - Innovation Center will be the anchor in preparing our students for the future of jobs.
- Innovation Center Update
 - Currently in the design finalizing phase.
 - Working on curriculum to be ahead of the needs when the center opens.
 - Hoping to start building the trades building in October. Renovations to the current building will be starting shortly after that.
 - Currently looking to hire a business development liaison who will work to connect the current programs with local businesses.
- Slide presentation will be sent to CEF Board Members before our next meeting in September.
