

Final Report CCID LAND Trust Plan 2024-25

The Board of Directors approved a LAND Trust Plan for last year that focused on two goals: 1). Increasing school-wide proficiency in ELA and Math by 2% as measured by spring RISE scores and EOY Acadience data; 2). 60% of students will achieve proficiency or above-proficiency as a schoolwide average as measured by the Acadience EOY Reading and Math benchmark assessments.

To implement the board's plan, the Administration spent the funds per the amounts and categories below.

RISE Outcomes by Subject

CCID's student data from the summative RISE test demonstrated the following increase in proficiency between FY24 and FY25 scores:

- 7.8% increase in proficiency in Science
- 0.4% increase in proficiency in Math
