Butlerville Monument Time Capsule Planning

GENERAL TIME CAPSULE IDEAS:

- Current newspapers: A copy of the Deseret News, the Salt Lake Tribune, and/or a local community newspaper.
 - Items representing popular culture: A list of the top movies, songs, and books of the year.
 - A sealed USB drive or hard drive: With digital versions of all the included documents and photos and instructions for how to use.

IDEAS FOR CITY MATERIALS:

- A "State of the City" document: A report detailing the city's current population, demographics, major projects, and possibly a letter from the mayor.
- Current City-branded items.
- Photos of key city landmarks.

- A current city budget summary of where the city's money is being spent. This will be fascinating for future generations to see.
 - A copy of the most recent city newsletter.
 - A map of Cottonwood Heights: A current city map showing roads, parks, and other features.
 - A selection of local business advertisements or flyers.

IDEAS FOR HISTORIC COMMITTEE MATERIALS:

- A summary of the Butlerville Monument project explaining the purpose of the monument, the planning process, and the history behind its location.
 - Photographs of the historic Butlerville area including old and new photos of the site where the monument is being built.
 - Historic register data on the Butler Teacher's Dormitory.
 - A printed list of all the historic markers and sites in Cottonwood Heights.
 - Historic walking guide brochures.
 - A letter from the Historic Committee to future residents.

IDEAS FOR BUTLER ELEMENTARY/CANYONS SCHOOL DISTRICT MATERIALS:

- Handwritten letters from students where they introduce themselves and ask a question about the future. For example, "What's the internet like now?" or "Do you still have homework?"
- A copy of the current school newspaper/newsletter.
- A list of the school's current faculty and staff. Including the principal, teachers, and other staff members.
- A letter from the principal with a message to the future community, reflecting on the school's current goals and challenges.
- A copy of the Canyons School District mission statement and recent annual report that gives a broader context of the educational system.
