BIO – Dan Johnson

Dr. Daniel Nolan Johnson grew up on a farm in Eastern Nebraska. This is where he learned many of life's lessons, especially the value of hard work. He is the first person in the generations of his family to graduate from college. Dan has five degrees from colleges and universities : Bachelor's Degree from Peru State Teachers College, Master's Degree from the University of Nebraska at Omaha, Educational Specialist Degree from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, and a Doctorate Degree in Educational Leadership. Dan has been an educator for 50 years, 8 years as a teacher and coach, 42 years as an administrator. He was the Principal at Mount Logan Middle School for 17 years, He served as the Assistant Superintendent for the Tooele County School District in Tooele, Utah, and retired in 2018 as the Director of Edith Bowen Laboratory School in the College of Education and Human Services on the campus of Utah State University. Following that, Dan was elected to the Utah House of Representatives. For 6 consecutive sessions, Dan proudly represented the citizens of Logan, River Heights, and Richmond in House District 3. Dr. Johnson is currently the Interim Executive Director of the Cache Refugee and Immigrant Connection (CRIC) where he is working to create a "Community for All."

Dan has been the recipient of several awards including Utah Principal of the Year, Runner-up for National Principal of the Year, Governor's "Point of Light" for his volunteer service, the Utah Council of the International Reading Association "Reading Principal of the Year", the Technology Leader of the Year in Utah, and while serving at the Capitol, Dan was recognized as the Utah Legislator of the Year and was celebrated for being a Business Champion six years in a row. His contributions to education were recognized when he

received the prestigious "Jon M. Huntsman Award for Excellence in Education."

Dan has been invited to the White House on two occasions to celebrate his contributions to education and to meet with federal officials.

Dan and his wife, Carol, have seven children. All of them have been educated in the public schools, colleges, and universities of America.

Note of interest: Dan and his wife have each run 50 marathons including the Boston Marathon where they both performed better than their qualifying times.
