



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Kane County Administrative Land Use Authority will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, October 8, 2025, at 4:00 p.m.** The meeting will take place in the Land Use Office located at the Kane County Courthouse, 76 North Main Street, Kanab, Utah.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider an application for a full boundary adjustment submitted on behalf of James R. Polnisch and Susan Farney-Polnisch to **combine lots 45-44, 45-45, & 45-46** in the Strawberry Valley Estates, Unit 4, Kane County, Utah. The proposal includes the following:

- **Combining Lots 44, 45 and 46 into a new Lot 46**, containing approximately 2.66 acres.
- **Vacating four 7.5-foot public utility easements by Ordinance 2025-34.**

Written objections to the petition must be submitted to the Land Use Authority by **October 7, 2025.**

If the application is approved on October 8, 2025, the Kane County Commission will hold a public hearing to approve/deny Ordinance 2025-34 vacating four 7.5 foot public utility easements on October 14, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Chambers at the Kane County Courthouse, 76 N. Main Street, Kanab, Utah.
