

1. Resolution to cancel November general election for 2025 read by clerk. Motion to accept the resolution made by Pace, 2nd by Larsen. Unanimous vote.
2. Proclamation for Constitution Week Sept 17-23 read by clerk. Motion to make Sept 17-23 Constitution week made by Allan, 2nd by Batty. Unanimous vote.
3. Resolution for Joint Agreement with Fire District read by clerk. Motion to accept the terms of the agreement made by Larsen, 2nd Pace, unanimous vote.
4. Kaitlin Solomon – Wants to use the park for a fund raiser and is asking council to waive the \$300 deposit required. Date would be September 19, 20th. Motion to waive the fee made by Allan, 2nd by Batty. Unanimous vote.
