MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF THE TOWN OF CLARKSTON

Town Council Meeting held at the Clarkston Town Hall, 50 South Main, Clarkston, UT

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Hidalgo called the Clarkston Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilmember A. Hanover led the Pledge of Allegiance, read a Post Pledge Reflection - See Exhibit A and offered reverence to begin the meeting.

Mayor Hidalgo addressed the minutes of the Clarkston Town Council Meeting held August 5, 2025. Councilmember A. Hanover motioned for the Clarkston Town Council to approve and adopt the minutes of August 5, 2025. Councilmember M. Kelly seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye". Motion Carried.

2. <u>BUSINESS</u>

Business License Application – Jeff Renshaw - Jeff Renshaw was present at the meeting. Mayor Hidalgo stated that the name of the business is Renshaw's Handyman Service LLC and is located at 30 South 100 East. Mayor Hidalgo explained that Mr. Renshaw would be traveling to homeowner's properties to complete projects for them. Monthly sales would be approximately \$2,000- \$3,000 per month. Mayor Hidalgo Councilmember D. Smith motioned to approve the business license with the above stipulation. Mayor Hidalgo recommended that prior to starting projects he makes sure the property owners have received proper permitting required for the project. Mr. Renshaw agreed. Councilmember A. Hanover motioned to approve the business license. Councilmember M. Stephensen seconded the motion. All in Favor "Aye". Motion carried

Town Clean-up Date/Plan –Mayor Hidalgo informed the Council that a general letter, drafted by Councilmember A. Hanover had been mailed out encouraging all Clarkston citizens to clean up their yards and take pride in their property and in our community. Mayor Hidalgo said that he had also sent out an email to the Bishops of Clarkston 1st and 2nd Wards asking for their assistance in providing people to help citizens that need help cleaning up their yards or hauling items to the dumpsters. The town would cover all clean-up costs incurred. It was determined that the Town Clean-up Day would be

September 24 - 29. There will be two roll-off dumpsters brought in for citizens to utilize in cleaning up their yards and beautifying the town.

<u>SCADA Upgrade Proposal</u> – Mayor Hidalgo presented a SCADA Upgrade Proposal from Rockwell Supply Company. <u>See Exhibit B</u>

Mayor Hidalgo stated that the Clarkston Town SCADA System is extremely antiquated. To be in compliance with water testing and reporting required by the State of Utah Division of Drinking Water the Clarkston Town SCADA system needs to be updated. It will cost approximately \$44,000. Mayor Hidalgo stated that he wanted the Council to be aware of the necessity and the cost of upgrading the SCADA System. It will need to be done within the next couple of years.

<u>Division of Drinking Water and Division of Water Quality Fee Proposals</u> - Mayor Hidalgo informed the Council that two divisions within Utah's Department of Environmental Quality – Drinking Water (DDW) and Water Quality (DWQ)- are proposing new Public Water System Fees that could significantly impact public water systems across the state, especially small and rural systems. They are accepting public input on the proposed fees and Mayor Hidalgo said he had already responded in opposition to the fees. The financial impact of these fees on Clarkston Town would be substantial. The fees would be effective July 1, 2026 with first payments due July 2027.

3. Departments

<u>Mayor Hidalgo – Fire Department</u> – Mayor Hidalgo reported that Kendrick Electric would be installing a Generac backup generator at the fire department and at the Town Hall. In the event of an emergency those two buildings will be completely operational.

Green Waste – Mayor Hidalgo reported that there has been a lot of abuse with the green waste dumpster this year. People are continuously putting items in the green waste dumpster that are not green waste. When this happens, the refuse must be taken to the landfill, and the town is charged the landfill price for tonnage. Mayor Hidalgo said that he had talked to T & S Advanced Waste about the abuse and found out that the owner Tileo Perez has been removing the non-green waste items from the dumpster at no charge to the town. Mayor Hidalgo stated that he doesn't think that it is fair for him to have to do that and if citizens of Clarkston can't abide by the concept of green waste and continue to misuse it the town needs to get rid of it. Mayor Hidalgo proposed that if it doesn't improve the town won't provide Green Waste Services next year. Councilmember A. Hanover and Councilmember M. Stephensen agreed with Mayor Hidalgo.

<u>Pickleball Grand Opening</u> – The Pickleball and Basketball Court Grand Opening will be held on September 4, 2025 at 7:00 pm. There will be some prize drawings, and light refreshments will be served.

<u>Councilmember M. Stephensen – August Warrant List</u> – Councilmember M. Stephensen presented the Warrant List for August 2025. Councilmember A. Hanover motioned for the Clarkston Town Council to approve the Warrant List as read. Councilmember M. Kelly seconded the motion. All in favor "Aye." Motion carried.

<u>Youth Council</u> – Councilmember M. Stephensen reported that the youth council would be meeting on September 13, 2025 to plan the Halloween Movie.

<u>Councilmember A. Hanover – Planning Commission</u> – Councilmember A. Hanover stated that the planning commission is just business as usual. They had approved several permits.

<u>Councilmember M. Kelly – Cemetery Department</u> – Councilmember M. Kelly reported that he had been notified that there was Morning Glory growing all over the cemetery. It needs to be mitigated so it doesn't take over the whole cemetery.

<u>Cache County School District</u>—The School Board Meeting, to go over the plans for the school boundary changes, is going to be on September 18, 2025. The Cache County School Board will allow public comment at the meeting.

<u>Councilmember J. Petersen – Roads Department</u> – Mayor Hidalgo reported that Christensen Construction would be starting the Drainage Project on 300 South next week.

4. RELEVANT BUSINESS

Public Comment

<u>Luke Rashall</u> – Referenced the green waste discussion and stated that if citizens continue to abuse the green waste service he is in favor of doing away with it. Mr. Rashall feels that the \$2.00 monthly Green Waste Fee should go to some other service, if people won't respect the green waste dumpster, such as saving to build more pickleball courts or trail systems or something like that.

Next Meeting – The next Town Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday September 16, 2025 at 7:00 pm.

5. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Council, Councilmember A. Hanover motioned that the Clarkston Town Council Meeting be adjourned. Councilmember J. Petersen seconded the motion. All members present voted "Aye." Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:48 p.m.

Controlling Provisions: The terms and conditions and supplemental exhibits contained herein (the "Terms and Conditions") shall supersede any provisions, terms, and conditions contained on any purchase order or other written form any direct buyer ("Buyer") may use or provide (whether received by S.J. Electro Systems, Inc. or any of its subsidiaries or affiliates (collectively, "SJE") prior or subsequent to the date hereof), and the rights of the parties shall be governed exclusively by the Terms and Conditions as described herein. SJE sells certain services, products, replacement parts and related software (collectively, the "Goods"). The purchase of the Goods is governed by the Terms and Conditions. Any communication by Buyer to SJE to purchase Goods will be tracted by SJE as a request to purchase the Goods. The response, however communicated, will purities as an agreement by SJE to sell to Buyer the requested Goods pursuant to the Terms and Conditions. SJE specifically opposes any terms or conditions that are in addition to or different from the Terms and Conditions, unless specifically agreed to in each instance in writing by SJE.

Quotations, Acceptance, and Agreements: Any quotation is a good faith estimate. To the extent that SIE has been provided by or on behalf of Buyer any specifications, description of operating conditions or other data and information in connection with the selection or design of the Goods, and the actual operating conditions or other circumstances differ from those provided by Buyer and relied upon by SIE, any warranties or other provisions contained herein which are affected by such conditions shall be

Acceptance of a quotation, whether by a separate purchase order or by other means, shall constitute an acknowledgement and approval of the quotation as written and an acceptance of the Terms and Conditions. Written quotations which have not been finalized by a binding purchase order shall expire on the date specified in the quotation or, in the absence of such specification, thirty (30) calendar days from the date issued. SJE may revise or withdraw a quotation at any time prior to the finalization of a binding purchase order.

Intellectual Property: All devices, patents, designs (including drawings, plans and specifications), software existing or to be developed, estimates, prices, notes, memos, summaries, electronic data and other documents or information prepared or disclosed by SIE shall tremain the sole intellectual property of SIE. Credit Approval: The credit terms granted on each order are subject to SJE's continuing approval of Buyer's credit. SJE may withdraw the extension of credit and require modified payment terms if, in SJE's sole judgment, Buyer's credit or financial standing is impaired such that SJE in good faith deems payment insecure.

Prices and Taxes: All prices are FOB shipping point, unless otherwise stated or referenced in attached exhibits. All prices are subject to any commercially reasonable additions that may be necessary to cover any duties, taxes or charges. All prices are in U.S. Dollars, Prices may be subject to change without notice.

Shipping Policy: Shipping and handling charges cover the transportation of the Goods from SJE's warehouse to Buyer, unless otherwise specified. Standard shipping rates are assessed upon placement of order. SJE uses many methods of shipment including UPS shipping services but reserves the right to substitute carriers without notice. UPS next-day air, UPS second-day air, UPS three-day ground, UPS Express and UPS Expedited are services available to Buyer for expediting orders. Expedited orders will be shipped based on the method Buyer selects. These services may not be available for shipment into all countries.

While SIE will use all reasonable commercial efforts to maintain the delivery date(s) acknowledged or quoted by SIE, all shipping dates are approximate and not guaranteed. SIE reserves the right to make partial shipments. SIE, at its option, shall not be bound to tender delivery of any Goods for which Buyer has not provided shipping instructions and other required information. If the shipment of the Goods is postponed or delayed by Buyer for any reason, Buyer agrees to reimburse SIE for any and all storage costs and other additional expenses resulting therefrom. The actual shipping weights may vary.

Title, Risk of Loss, Inspection of Equipment: Title and risk of loss to the Goods shall pass to Buyer upon delivery of the Goods to the respective delivery carrier. Buyer shall immediately inspect the Goods upon receipt and any damages numt be noted on the delivery carrier's bull of lading at time of receipt. SIE is not liable for any damages caused by shipping. SIE is not hable for any shortages or nonconformance unless notified by Buyer within two (2) bunness days of Buyer's receipt of the Goods.

Operations/Maintenance Manuals: Installation, maintenance and operation manuals will be furnished to Buyer in the number of copies specified at the time of quotation or order. Additional copies subject to charges as outlined in attached exhibits

Installation and Use: Buyer will be solely responsible for the proper application, installation and service of the Goods. Installation instructions are supplied by SJE and must be followed

Esport/Import: Buyer agrees that all applicable import and export control laws, regulations, orders and requirements, including, but not limited to, those of the United States and the European Union, and the jurisdictions in which SJE and Buyer are established or from which Goods may be supplied, will apply to their receipt and use. In no event shall Buyer use, transfer, release, import, or export Goods in violation of such applicable laws, regulations, orders or requirements.

Payment: Buyer shall pay SJE the full purchase price as set forth in the respective order between SJE and Buyer. Unless otherwise agreed to in writing between SJE and Buyer, freight, storage, insurance, taxes, duties, and any governmental charges relating to the Goods shall be paid by Buyer. If SJE is required to pay any such charges, Buyer shall immediately reimburse SJE upon notice from SJE of same. All payments are due within approved credit terms. Buyer may be charged the lower of 1.5% interest per month or the maximum legal rate on all amounts not received by the due date described therein.

Security Interest: SJE shall retain a security interest in the Goods until the full purchase price has been paid. Buyer's failure to pay any amounts due, including interest, shall give SJE the right to possession and removal of the Goods after providing ten (10) days written notice to Buyer. SJE's taking of such possession shall be without prejudice to any other remedies SJE may have.

Changes, Cancellations, Returns: Buyer may request changes or additions to the Goods consistent with SJE's specifications and criteria. In the event such changes or additions are accepted by SJE, SJE shall have the absolute right to revise the prices and dates of delivery, and to add charges for work and materials rendered unnecessary by such changes or additions. All changes, cancellations, or returns must have SJE prior written approval and subject to restocking fees and service charges. Authorized returns must be packaged and shipped prepaid to SJE.

Return Policy: SIE will only accept Goods returned within one (1) year from the date of manufacture, un-used, and current production models. Returned Material Authorization ("RMA") numbers must be assigned to any Goods Buyer wishes to return for credit. To obtain an RMA, Buyer must contact SIE is Service Center at 218-847-1317 or toll free at 888-342-5753. Buyer is responsible for payment of return shipping fees unless such returned Goods result from an SIE order processing error. In the event of Superior for the return freight cerulting from the return of Goods and to results correct Goods to Buyer. SIE reterves the right to refuse acceptance of returned Goods after inspection. SIE will not accept returns for Goods that are custom-built for Buyer as such items cannot be resold by SIE; however, custom-built Goods remain subject to applicable warranty provisions in each case
