## DEFINITIONS:

10 All terms used in this chapter shall have the same meaning as those found in section 41-  
11 6a-102 of the Utah Code, or successor provision.

## 7-6-2 – RESTRICTIONS ON OPERATIONS:

14 Golf carts may be operated within the City pursuant to the following:

- A. Golf carts may not be operated by persons under 16 years of age.
- B. Golf carts may not be operated on any public trail or path, or within a city-designated park.
- C. Golf carts may not be operated on roadways where the posted speed limit is greater than 30 miles per hour.
- D. Golf carts may not be operated after civil sunset or before civil sunrise.
- E. Golf carts may not be operated with more passengers than the number of individuals for which the golf cart was originally manufactured.
- F. All golf cart passengers under the age of 16 must wear a bicycle helmet or DOT approved helmet.

### 7-6-3 - TRAFFIC RULES:

27 A golf cart shall comply with the same requirements as a bicycle for traffic rules under Utah  
28 Code title 41, chapter 6a, or successor provision.

30 7-6-4 - VIOLATION:

31      A. It is unlawful for a parent or guardian to allow a person under the age of 16 to violate  
32            this chapter

33      B. A violation of this chapter may be prosecuted as a class B misdemeanor or by a civil  
34            citation.
