Nick Galloway reviewed the audit report for 2024. The board members reviewed the loan with Rural Development. Nick Galloway reviewed the self-evaluation form with board members. Nick Galloway reviewed the proposed fees for Utah Public Water Systems. PFAS monitoring is required by the federal government and new fees for sampling will be required. He then reviewed the budget for 2026. Revenues were reviewed by the board members also the expenses for 2025. After reviewing budget and upcoming fees it was suggested that an increase of monthly charges for service be increased from \$40 to \$45 for residential and an increase from \$50 to \$55 for industrial use and extra water use will increase from \$1.00 to \$1.20. Ferris Jorgensen made a motion to approve the pre-budget for 2026. John Allen seconded the motion. All board members present were in favor of the motion.
