    - d Jason will outline the SOW for Joe Town, Prescott will outline the SOW for East Bench and Nature Park
  - 2 Bid process:
    - a Allison will post to required places
    - b Recommend going through J&D posting process to get more results
    - c Youth trail crew (hand tools only)
      - i 14+ age
      - ii Weekdays after school and Saturdays
      - iii September-December (or as long as weather permits)
