Minutes of September 17, 2025

Councilman Christensen moved to approve the minutes from September 17, 2025. Seconded by Councilman Hammond. Carries 5-0.

Centerfield City Youth Council

Nine youth council members are in attendance to inform the city of their current activities and meetings. They were involved in the Sanpete County fair parade, as well as helped at the harvest days festival. They are wondering what else they can do to help and be involved within the city. They would like to help with the Trunk or Treat activity. Mayor Leatherwood commented that the city will find things for them to do if they are willing to help.

Revote on Kasey Peterson out of town water connections

Kasey came before the city to ask the city if they will extend services to the six lots previously discussed in the July 16, 2025 meeting. Kasey offered to bring the line to the corner so the city would not incur any financial burden. Three councilmen were in attendance that day and it was later found out that the vote was not valid for Kasey to be granted permission to extend those 6 hookups. Kasey is willing to make it final in his covenants that the irrigation water stays with the ground permanently in the subdivision and will not leave the property.

Councilman Christensen made a motion to grant Kasey Peterson six out of town culinary hookups for his lots located at 400 North in the Bexley Farms subdivision. Kasey will extend the line from the city boundary at his cost. Motion amended to add Kasey will tie adequate irrigation water shares to those six lots and have it in the Bexley Farms Subdivision covenants stating it has to permanently stay with the lot. Seconded by Councilwoman Fisher. Carries 4-1. Yay- Councilman Christensen, Councilwoman Fisher, Councilman Hammond, Councilman Stewart. Nay- Councilman Hansen.

Trunk or Treat- October 31 @ 6 pm

Trunk or Treat is scheduled for Friday the 31st @ 6 pm Mayor Leatherwood will make the hot chocolate. The Mayor is encouraging all the council to attend.

Gunnison Valley Police Department- Chief Adamson Report

Chief Adamson is in attendance to update the council on the Police Department activities for the last month. There have been more calls and the chief believes that it is the public trusting the department more. Centerfield had 37 calls in the previous month.

General Plan/Annexation Discussion

If the city decides to annex, a lot of conversations will need to be had with landowners. Water is a big thing that needs to be figured out before big changes can be made.

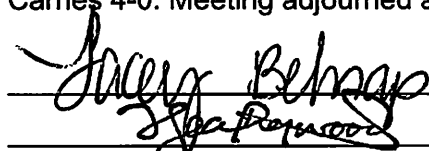
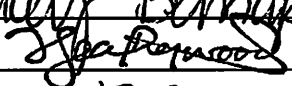
Bart Hammond-
