APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

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grazing improvement. Possibility of becoming part of the watershed plan. Breanne also gave an overview of the Sevier Conservation District fair held at the Blackhawk.

NRCS

Wade Ingram mentioned that NRCS is 100% obligated for 2025. There are no renewals or deferring on CSP's. New applications have to be done. Wade also mentioned that there will be changes in the ways funds are assigned and there will be Utah focused opportunities for SFP's. New applications are due Oct/Nov for 2026.

EXTENSION

Trent Wilde proposed a sponsorship for the board. He would like to partner on a dryland range reseeding project. The study would consist of using a range drill versus a drone. The plan is to use a hearty grass that is resistant to drought and other harsh conditions like Siberian wheat grass. Trent and the board discussed approximate costs for the project including the rental of the range drill and seed. The topic was tabled until the next meeting when a quorum would be present to vote on the sponsorship.
