



PUBLIC NOTICE OF 2025 MUNICIPAL ELECTION
Issued Pursuant to Utah Code § 20A-5-101

The Town of Hideout will participate in the **General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2025**. All qualified voters are encouraged to take part in this important opportunity to shape their community's future.

Election Day and Polling Hours

Voters may cast their ballots in person on **Tuesday, November 4, 2025, between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.**

Where to Vote

Election Day voting and early voting will take place at the:

Wasatch County Administration Building

Early Voting

Early in-person voting will be available from **Tuesday, October 25 through Friday, October 31, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** at the same location.

Returning Your Ballot

Voters may return their voted mail ballot in one of two ways:

1. Deposit it in any official Wasatch County ballot drop box **before 8:00 p.m.** on Election Day (November 4, 2025); or
2. Mail the ballot early enough to be **received by the county clerk before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.**
 - Late ballots – those received after 8:00 p.m. – cannot be counted, even if postmarked that day.

Who Can Vote

To participate in this election, you must:

- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Have been a resident of Utah for at least 30 days immediately before the election; and
- Be 18 years of age or older on or before Election Day.
