**ORDINANCE NO. 25-49**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2009 WEST JORDAN CITY CODE;**  
**AMENDING SECTION 13-5E-3,**  
**ALLOWING FOR MOTOR VEHICLE SALES AND SERVICE**  
**AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN THE C-M (HEAVY COMMERCIAL) ZONE**

WHEREAS, the City of West Jordan (“City”) adopted West Jordan City Code (“City Code”) in 2009; and the City Council of the City (“Council” or “City Council”) desires to amend City Code Section 13-5E-3, to allow for Motor Vehicle Sales and Service as a Conditional Use in the C-M (Heavy Commercial) Zone (“proposed City Code amendments”); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City (“Planning Commission”) held a public hearing and provided a recommendation on September 2, 2025, regarding the proposed City Code amendments; and determined the following, pursuant to City Code Section 13-7D-6B:

1. The proposed City Code amendments conform to the General Plan and are consistent with the adopted goals, objectives and policies described therein;
2. The proposed City Code amendments are appropriate given the context of the request and there is sufficient justification for a modification to the land use titles;
3. The proposed City Code amendments will not create a conflict with any other section or part of the land use titles or the General Plan; and
4. The proposed City Code amendments do not relieve a particular hardship, nor do they confer any special privileges to a single property owner or cause, and they are only necessary to make a modification to the land use titles in light of corrections or changes in public policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on October 14, 2025, regarding the proposed City Code amendments, and finds it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City to adopt the proposed City Code amendments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Amendment of City Code Provisions.** With regards to the City Code, Section 13-5E-3 is amended, as shown in Attachments A (legislative version) and B (clean version) to this Ordinance.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon posting or publication as provided by law and upon (i) the Mayor signing the Ordinance, (ii) the City Council duly overriding the veto of the Mayor as provided by law, or (iii) the Mayor failing to sign or veto the Ordinance within fifteen (15) days after the City Council presents the Ordinance to the Mayor.

Those uses identified as "permitted" (P) are allowed by right; provided, that they comply with all other requirements of this article, and all other applicable requirements of this title. Uses identified as "conditional" (C) must be approved by the Planning Commission pursuant to the standards and procedures for conditional uses set forth in chapter 7, article E of this title and title 15 of this Code, and comply with all other applicable requirements of this title. Uses identified as "administrative conditional uses" (AC) shall be approved by the Zoning Administrator pursuant to the standards set forth in chapter 7, article E of this title, except that the public hearing shall be conducted by the Zoning Administrator, and shall comply with title 15 of this Code, and all other applicable requirements of this title.
