

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF 2025 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

The 2025 Municipal General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025. Ballots will be mailed out to registered voters between October 14, 2025, and October 28, 2025. To receive a ballot, voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the City in which they are registered.

Registered voters who do not receive a ballot or anyone with questions about their ballot should contact the Cache County Clerk's Office at www.CacheCounty.org/Elections or call the Cache County Clerk's Office at 435-755-1460.

Election Day In-Person Voting will be on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Cache County Event Center (Fairgrounds), 490 South 500 West, Logan, Utah. VALID VOTER IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED. Any changes to the location of a polling place and/or the location of any additional polling places will be noticed on the Statewide Electronic Voter Information Website at wote.utah.gov. Additionally, voters may receive important voter updates, including polling locations and changes, on the Cache County website at www.cache.county.gov/elections

Early Voting In Person will be held Tuesday, October 28, 2025, through Friday, October 31, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Cache County Administration Building, 179 North Main, Multi-Purpose Room, Logan, Utah. VALID VOTER IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.

Options for Voters with Disabilities: Vote by Mail - All active, registered voters in Cache County are mailed a ballot three weeks before election day. Voters can then fill out their ballot at home and return it through the U.S. Postal Mail or by putting it in one of the Drop Boxes located throughout the county. If a voter has difficulty signing their ballot, they can reach out to the County Election Office for accommodations. In-Person Voting - If a voter prefers, they can go to one of our vote centers to vote in person on election day. All vote centers are ADA compliant. Additionally, touch-screen voting machines with assistive technology are available for voters to use at all vote centers. Ballots can be returned by mail (postage is paid); in person at the Cache County Clerk's Office, 179 North Main; or at an official ballot drop box location. Ballot boxes close at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, and no ballots will be accepted after this time. Postmark date is no longer accepted. Ballots must be received by November 4, 2025.
