Subject: Millcreek Canyon Shuttle Feasibility Study Update Timeline

Staff will present the draft update to the Millcreek Canyon Shuttle Feasibility Study for Board consideration and review during the October 31st Board meeting. The CWC opened an initial public comment period on the scope and concept of the Millcreek Canyon Shuttle in July 2025. 375 comments were submitted to the CWC. In October 2025, the CWC released the draft update to the feasibility study and opened a second public comment period on the draft study. About 90 comments were received.

The final update to the feasibility study will be presented to the CWC for review and approval during the January Board meeting. Between now and January, staff and the drafting consultants will incorporate changes reflective of the received public comments, where applicable, and convene a meeting with agency partners (Salt Lake County, UDOT, Granite School District, Millcreek City, and the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest) to review the draft study and make any necessary changes.
