AgVIP Updates



- Contract obligation is complete: \$1,512,680 enrolling 45,466 acres
- Site visits complete
- Plans will be completed and signed by producers this year
- Plan implementation will begin during 2026 crop year
- Starting annual record keeping payments - (\$487,887 in total)
- 22 producers graduating from the program
- Next application cycle will be spring 2026
- Submitted building block request for \$1 million ongoing

Soil Health Updates



- Local soil health workshops have continuing via AgSHOP grant:
 - **Daggett CD** Soil Health Workshop was on **10/8**
 - **Northern UT** Soil Health Conference was on **10/29 & 10/30**
 - **Grand CD** Soil Health Workshop will be on **11/12**
- Next round of AgSHOP applications in spring 2026


