Item #1: The Salt Lake County Health Department is proposing amendments to the Health Regulation #21, *Community Noise Pollution Control*.

Action for the Board: We are asking the Board to hold a public hearing for Health Regulation #21 and to assign a hearing officer.

Summary of Changes

The Community Noise Pollution Control regulation is proposed with the following revisions:

- Non-substantive clerical and grammatical corrections throughout.
- Changed “shall mean” to “means” in all definitions of Section 2.
- General formatting and numbering corrected throughout Regulation.
- Amended references throughout Regulation to reflect correct sections and codes.
- Amended Purpose & Applicability of Regulation in 1.1.
- Removed definitions for “Board,” “Dynamic Braking Device,” “EPA,” “Exhaust System,” “Gross Vehicle Weight Rating,” “Infrasound,” “Motor Vehicle,” “Muffler,” “Noise Control System,” “Off-highway vehicle,” “Ultrasound,” and “Z-Weighted South Pressure Level or dBZ or db(Z).”
- Added definitions for “Crowd Noise,” and “Noise Sampling Plan (NSP).”
- Amended definitions throughout.
- Clarified maximum permissible sound pressure levels and property types.
- Table 1 amended for clarifying language.
- Table 1b & 2 removed.
- All references for Motor Vehicles (4.6.3) removed.
- Added Construction Equipment Exemption.
- Amended Firework and Explosives Exemptions specifications for simplification.
- Amended Department Authority.
- Removed permit waiver information (5.4.2-5.4.3).
- Added processes for Departmental Conferences, Settlement Agreements, and

Stipulations & Orders 7.3.6.

- Added information for Hearings & Appeals 7.3.6.
- Amended Appendix A for more concise property types.
