  - ii) The Commission recommended the support for the application of the Grant for McCowan Technology Corporation to the Council. The Commission's vote was unanimous in its support (by the 5 present) and was taken on Oct 24, 2025

    - 1) Motion passed 3 to 1
  - v) (Jonathan) does not support programs like RCOG, He doesn't support the use of taxpayer funded grants for private companies, regardless of whether those funds originate the state level, the federal level, the city level. Jonathan also felt there needed to be a policy in place for how the city handles sponsoring grants.

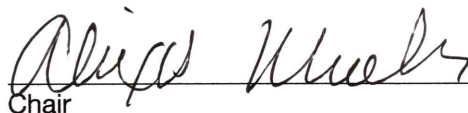
